Early detection of COVID-19 in health care workers is an important protective mechanism for the higher risk population that may come in contact with them. Health care workers should have a lower threshold for testing for COVID-19 if they provide direct care and therefore be tested if they have: • a fever (≥ 37.5); AND • symptoms of an acute respiratory infection (e.g. shortness of breath, cough, sore throat). This is in addition to the standard requirements for testing health care workers as returned travellers.
